### ORDINANCE NO. 2017-17

#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA AMENDING CHAPTER 17, SALES; ARTICLE 17, GARAGE SALES; SECTION 17-27, GENERAL RESTRICTION UPON SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY, SECTION 17-30 MOTOR VEHICLES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**Whereas,** the City Council of the City of Neptune Beach, Florida has determined that it is necessary to amend the following:

Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Neptune Beach, Florida:

**Section 1**. Chapter 17, Sales; Article II, Garage Sales; section 17-27 General restriction upon sale of personal property and Section 17-30 Motor Vehicles; shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 17-27. - General restriction upon sale of personal property.

Except as otherwise provided in this Code, no person shall display for sale, upon any residentially zoned property or upon any commercially zoned property except in connection with a business licensed to conduct retail sales under this chapter, nor advertise the availability for purchase at any such location, nor sell or offer to sell at any such location, any personal property not associated with the issued business license.

Sec. 17-30. - Same—Motor vehicles.

Notwithstanding section 17-29, not more than one (1) motor vehicle offered for sale in residential zoning districts may be kept or displayed on any portion of a permanently constructed driveway on the property owned or occupied by the owner of such vehicle.

Section 2. The Ordinance shall become effective on after passage by the City Council.
