ORDINANCE NO. 2018-02

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 27, UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT
REGULATIONS; ARTICLE I, SECTION 27-15, DEFINITIONS
(WORSHIP FACILITY); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Neptune Beach, Florida has determined that it is necessary to amend the following:

Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Neptune Beach, Florida:

Section 1. Chapter 27, Unified Land Development Regulations, Article I, Section 27-15 Definitions, shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 27-15. - Definitions

The purpose of this Code, certain terms and phrases are defined. Where words or terms are not defined, they shall have their ordinarily accepted meanings or such as the context may imply. Words and phrases that apply to more than one (1) article or division are defined below and shall have the meaning ascribed to them, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

...

Worship facility means a building used primarily as a place wherein persons regularly assemble for religious worship, instruction or education, including churches, synagogues, temples, sanctuaries, chapels and cathedrals and buildings associated with same such as parsonages, friaries, convents, fellowship halls, Sunday schools, and rectories. Parochial child day care centers and primary and/or secondary educational facilities that are owned or operated by an established worship facility shall be included in this definition.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective after passage by the City Council.
